ADVANCED PROGRAM

The **PADI Advanced** program offers divers the opportunity to fine tune navigation skills, expand diving depth limits beyond 60 feet, and explore three other specialties*. In addition to the Navigation and Deep dives, the Advanced Program allows divers to choose 3 other supervised dives from a menu of specialized diving activities including: Night, Boat, Drift, Dry Suit, Multilevel, Search & Recovery, Fish ID, Underwater Photography, Wreck Diving, Peak Buoyancy, and many more. This program may be taken after the Adventures in Diving program or, for divers with a high comfort level and a solid grasp of the basic dive skills, immediately following Open Water certification. If you sign up for the Advanced Program within two weeks of your previous certification, you will get *free rental* for the certification dives!

*If program is taken after Adventures in Diving, only Navigation and Deep dives need to be completed.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

- 1 Academic session
- 5 Dives conducted over 2 days OR
- 2 Dives conducted in 1 day (if taken after Adventures in Diving course)

PADI Open Water Diver certification or equivalent
