# DEEP DIVER COURSE

Develop the skills and knowledge to plan, organize, and enjoy no-decompression diving between the depths of 60 to 130 feet by enrolling in the **PADI Deep Diver Specialty** course. Proficiency in deep diving techniques increases the availability of dive sites and underwater activities for the recreational diver. Many unique wrecks and opportunities to dive walls are found in depths greater than 60 feet.
