DRIFT DIVER COURSE

The **PADI Drift Diver** course provides students with the skills, knowledge, techniques, hazards and enjoyment of drift diving. Students will learn to plan and organize safe and fun drift dives by using drift diving techniques. The course is intended to serve as a safe and supervised introduction to drift diving in the underwater environment. “Learn to effortlessly ‘soar’ underwater”.
