

PADI RESCUE DIVER PROGRAM

The **PADI Rescue Diver** program develops the necessary knowledge and skills to perform diver rescues and assists, manage diving-accident situations, and render proper diver first aid. Successful completion of the course qualifies individuals for PADI Divemaster training, and is also an important prerequisite for the **PADI Master Scuba Diver*** rating which is the highest non-professional level of scuba certification!

*Master Scuba Diver requires Rescue certification plus five specialty certifications

PREREQUISITES

PADI Advanced Open Water Diver/Junior Advanced Open Water or an equivalent rating with 20 logged dives

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

2 Academic Lectures & Pool sessions

5 Open Water Sessions covering 12 exercises (1 Academic session for CPR/First-Aid Training, unless you already have a current CPR certification)

COURSE FEE

\$285, includes PADI Rescue Diver Packet, DVD, dive management slate, gear for pool, and CPR/First-Aid training with manual (CPR/FA can be deducted if you are already trained, and current)
