

PADI SEARCH & RECOVERY DIVER COURSE

Often the successful recovery of lost weight belts, masks, wallets, and sunglasses from the water requires skills beyond the entry level diver. The skills and knowledge to plan, organize, and conduct methodical search patterns and recovery procedures can be obtained by enrolling in the **PADI SEARCH & RECOVERY SPECIALTY** course. Participants learn various compass and rope search patterns useful in recovering small to medium sized objects. These same skills prove invaluable to the Rescue Diver as well.
