WRECK DIVER COURSE

The thrill of discovery lures divers to wrecks. The establishment of artificial reefs by submerging ships, tanks, planes, and concrete structures increases the accessibility of wrecks for the recreational diver. Wreck diving, especially on historical wrecks, often challenges divers with deeper environments, water currents, and unstable structures. The **PADI Wreck Diver Specialty** course develops practical knowledge of the underwater wreck environment, increases awareness of the historical values of wrecks, and instructs divers on how to safely explore wrecks.
